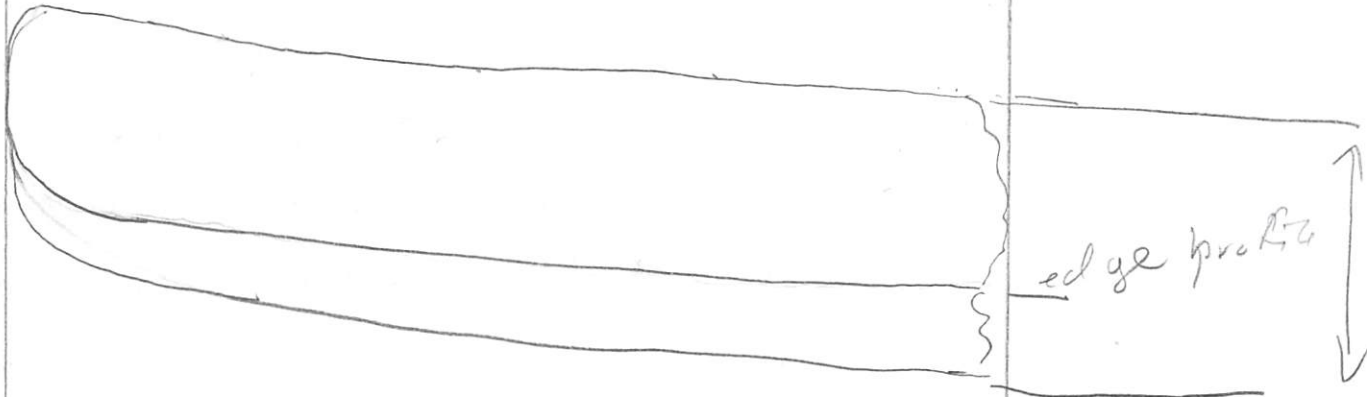

Full Verbal Description: Corner piece of a metate from the side with only one leg. The underside is ground, but not to the point of being flat. This side curves up to meet both finished edges, but the curve is steeper than usual, resulting in close to 90 degree angles between the underside and the edges. The upper surface is ground, and probably used, to the point that the higher areas are flat and somewhat slick and glossy. The working surface has an end-to-end curvature, but is flat side-to-side. The vesicular basalt has predominantly small holes, with the holes unevenly distributed, making hole-rich and hole-poor areas.
