Small fragment of a metate. Bottom is roughly shaped into a slight arch; top surface is slightly flat, yet very rough + shows no use-wear signs at all. In fact, it looks as though it was shaped but never completed, possibly, as it is very rough on both surfaces. The ~~curvature~~ curvature of the bottom suggests it is a corner piece, with a small chunk out of one edge, and 2 broken-off edges.
