This indent³ made the xiiij day of September in the yere of our lord godd a thousand
foure hundredth, thirty and three be wrot henry the abbot of Roche and Cobent of the same
place of the one pte and one Rauff Westby of Rancfeld gentleman of the othe pte
witnesseth and recordeth that the said Abbott and Cobent have dimissed and to
ferme latten vnto the said Rauff the taks and fermehold in Rancfeld called the mouke
yng and thre messes w^{ch} the apptm^{ts} now being in holding and occupation of the
said Rauff **To haue** and holde all the said mouke yng and thre messes w^{ch} y^e
apptm^{ts} vnto the said Rauff his heires and assignes from the next feast of S^{aynt}
martry in wynt^r folowynge the date here of vnto the end and full tyme of y^elmy yeres
they next folowynge to be fully completed and tyme by payng yerely the fore vnto the
said Abbott Cobent and to y^e Success^{rs} ym^{ch} of good and lawfull moncy of
yngland by even p^{er}sones that is to say at enery Whitsontide by ym^{ch} and at the
y^elmy at eny feast of S^{aynt} martry in wynt^r and if it happen the said d^{em}
all t^{en}t of ym^{ch} to be behynd and nott p^{ay}d in pte or in hole at any of the
said feasts when it shuld be p^{ay}d they it shalbe lawfull vnto the said Abbott Cobent
and to y^e Success^{rs} to distresse in. sh. or vpon the said mouke yng and thre messes
sted^s or any p^{ar}t of them and the distresse so taken to carry le^{ad} and dryff away
and them to deteyn vnto they be fully content and p^{ay}d of all such t^{en}t^s and
arverages if any be and if it happen the said yerely t^{en}t of ym^{ch} to be
behynd and nott p^{ay}d in pte or in all by the space of a quarter of a yere if it
be lawfully asked after any of the said feasts they it shalbe lawfull vnto the
said Abbott Cobent and to y^e Success^{rs} to recenter vnto the said mouke yng and
thre messes w^{ch} the apptm^{ts} and vnto the said Rauff his heires
and assignes for eny this present dimission in any thing to the contrary
nott standynge **In witness** of all the premisses aswell the said Abbott &
Cobent as the said Rauff have set to thre presens th^{er} y^e Common Seal as the
said Rauff by his Signett y^even at Roche the xiiij day of y^elmy a yere abovesaid
