At a View of Frank Sledge Court Leet and Great Court Baron of Thomas Orby Hunter Esquire Lord of the said Manor holden for the same at the House of William Phillips known by the Sign of the Marquis of Granby in Crowland aforesaid on Wednesday the thirtieth day of October in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and Ninety nine By ^{30 October} 1799 ¹⁷⁹⁹ Hullwood Sanderson Gentleman Chief Steward of the Courts of the said Manor amongst other things it is thus enrolled.

At this Court came Henry Walton of Borough Hen in the County of Northampton Gentleman in his proper person and prayed by virtue of a Surrender bearing date the twenty seventh day of October One thousand seven hundred and eighty three and made from him and his late wife Mary Walton deceased and entered in the Court Rolls of this Manor to be Admitted Tenant to all that piece of Land whereon a half copyhold Messuage or Cottage some time since stood lying and being in the North Street of Crowland aforesaid between Lands heretofore of Edward Mansfield since of Joseph Fletcher and William Miller South Lands of Seth Williamson North and the Water of Welland West and two Acres of Land in the Alderlands with the Appurtenances To whom the Lord of this Manor by their said Steward did deliver seizin thereof by the Rod To hold to him the said Henry Walton his Heirs and Assigns of the Lord at the Will of the Lord of this Manor according to the Custom thereof by Healty Suit of Court and the Ancient Rents and Services therefrom due and of Right Accustomed (Saving to every one their Right) And he paying the Fine as in the Margin set for his Entry therein was Admitted Tenant thereto and his Healty was Respited.
