Dear Brother

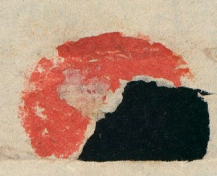

I'm nothing as I so truly happy as
communicating that which I know will give pleasure
to my friends and connections— Therefore the task
now is very pleasing— I have heard from Heber.
The news as direct as within eight days— Mr Billy
Phelps saw him at Niagara and dined with him
at his Brother's Deerpark. He was in good
spirits & had good prospects— Was then wait-
ing for Governor's arrival, that he
might get approbated as a Physician—
Then was going to ~~the~~ sail on the lake for
Detroit— about 3 hundred miles from thence. There
should undoubtedly go into the practice of this.
Mr Phelps said he had the care of about 2 or 3 hun-
dred pounds ~~the~~ worth of goods— that Heber said
they were not his— but did not enquire any farther.
I asked him if he said any thing respecting one
of my brothers who was also at the westward?
He said he did not— That, perhaps, he wrote
in his packet of letters which I left thro
a mistake at White creek in York— which
he said would be sent on to there in about 3 weeks
as he agreed with a person who was going to North river
& should return in that time— to find & fetch them—
I am in a haste as you see by my writing— I pray you to for-
give it— Write to me & hear you and what you think
about the 2 or 3 hundred \$ I will have this in Corbett's Philadelphia shop
