The Court Baron of Charles Anderson Pelham Esquire Lord of the  
Manor aforesaid there hold the Sixteenth day of November in the Ninth  
year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the Third by the Grace of  
God of Great Britain France and Ireland King Defender of the  
Faith and so forth and in the Year of our Lord One Thousand and Seven  
Hundred and Sixty Eight Before William Kirkmond and Thomas Harrison  
two Suitors of the Court aforesaid by William Hildyard Gentleman  
Steward there

At this Court came William Baldwin (a customary Tenant of the said Manor)  
to wit on the said Sixteenth day of November in the Year of our Lord One Thousand  
and Seven hundred and Sixty Eight and in Open Court (by a Rod) According to the Custom  
of the said Manor Did Surrender into the Hands of the Lord of the said Manor by  
the Hands of the said Steward All his Copyhold Messuages Lands Tenements  
and Hereditaments whatsoever Situate lying and being in North Coats &  
aforesaid within the Manor aforesaid To the Use and Behoof of such  
Person and Persons and for such Estate and Estates as the said William  
Baldwin by his last Will and Testament hath Directed Limitted &  
Declared and Appointed or shall Direct Limitt Declare and Appoint
