W. J. Bryan Says So And Gives His Reasons.

(William J. Bryan's letter to New York Journal.)

In answer to your inquiry, I submit some of the reasons which lead me to believe that the money question presented an issue which is still paramount in importance.

After thus elevating the question to the place of supreme importance the platform proceeded to point out the effect of an appreciating dollar and declared the unalterable opposition of the party to the gold standard.

Second--That the standard silver dollar be made a full legal tender equally with gold for all debts, public and private.

Third--That the enactment of such legislation as will prevent for the future the demonetization of any kind of legal tender money by private contract.

Fourth--That the United States shall not surrender its right to redeem its obligations in either gold or silver.

Recent events have demonstrated that Europe has turned the money question over to England, and England seems to have turned it over to the English financiers.

The Democratic party could have reclaimed its own platform by the withdrawal of foreign capital to prevent a change of our financial policy.
