Samuel Mucas

For Beauty Wit for Sterling sense
For Temper Mild, for Eloquence
For courage bold for things warrelike
He was the glory of Mohegan
Whose death hath caused great lamentation
Both to the English & the Indian Nation

Here lies Simeon Mucas the Second and
beloved son of his Father John Mucas
who was the Grandson of Mucas
Grand Sachem. He died July 31st
1741 in the 15th year of his age

Here lies y^e Body of Pompei Mucas son
of Benjamin & Ann Mucas & of y^e
Royal Blood who dyed May y^e 1. 1740
in y^e 21 year of his age

Here lies the Bodies of 2 infant children
of Benjamin Mucas son & of Ann Mucas
of y^e Royal Blood, one died Nov^r y^e 8 1738
y^e other Dec y^e 10th
