MURDERED BY A PRIEST. Father O'Grady Fatally Shoots Mary Gilmarin at Cincinnati. The Murderer Makes an Effort to End His Own Life by Taking Poison.

CINCINNATI, April 25.—Mary Gilmarin, a clerk employed by the Pulvermacher Belt company on Sycamore street, was shot and killed today while on her way to her work. The murderer was the namesake of George Reed, but letters found on him prove him to be the Father Dominick O'Grady, a Catholic priest who came from Ireland three months ago. Miss Gilmarin is from Silgo county, Ireland. One of her brothers is Father S. M. Gilmarin of Chicago. Miss Gilmarin was a bright, intelligent girl, and well liked in the neighborhood where she lived. Her father, Father Dominick O'Grady, is a well-known priest in this city.
