Statement of business left in my hands  
for settlement by the Rev<sup>d</sup> Philander Chase,  
and for which I am to account to him or  
his lawful representative —

One Judgment against John J. Caiman  
in Dutchess Common Pleas for one hun-  
dred and eighty six dollars and fifty four  
cents besides costs —

One Judgment in the Supreme Court  
against John Brooke for one hundred  
and twenty one dollars and fifty cents and  
Int. from 27<sup>th</sup> June 1805 —

One Note against Daniel S. Dean on which  
a suit is commenced, for one hundred and fifty  
six dollars and three cents, dated 21<sup>st</sup> March 1806,  
on which said Note Mr Dean has a set off  
amount not exactly known — John Atkins  
Poughkeepsie Oct 15<sup>th</sup> 1806 —



I Philander Chase give unto Dudley Chase Esquire  
of Randolph Vermont, power of Attorney to  
act as my lawful Representative in  
collecting receiving and applying the within  
mentioned amounts judgments and estate  
as he shall think best for the interest of  
me and my family Philander Chase
