Since 2000, he has generously made these accessible to fellow teachers and medieval art aficionados on his website archive. While many of these monuments are not medieval -- a good portion of them are. Even better, the stunning photos include excellent details of often-hard to photograph works (such as interior mosaics and wall paintings).
