VERBAL DESCRIPTION: Whole - fragmentary rectangular mouthpiece from an ocarina or whistle. If an ocarina, it is single - multi- chambered.

Hole is 0.6 cm wide; 0.42 cm high; 1.75 cm long. It is centered - off center.

Basal hole is absent - present. It measures long by cm wide. OR Can't tell size.

Interior does - does not have a bulb; does - does not have a clay curl - clay slab.

Interior shows smoothing - clay layering - finger marks - gouging - striations - wiping - "wet" look - unclear finish.

Firing core is absent - central - interior shifted.

Exterior shows smoothing - wiping - burnishing - irregularities - undulations - roughness - unclear finish.

Drawn - Not drawn. Piece is not slightly - moderately - very - extremely eroded.
