VERBAL DESCRIPTION:

Fragment of a flat face - but an *Cerina*.

The plate is coarse, even for an "I" design.
The fragment includes the two arms bent so
that the hands rest on the abdomen on either
side of a rectangular pectoral. The arms include
raised, smooth cuffs or wristlets & the hands include
& fingers defined by 3 wide, deep grooves. The
legs are bent at the knee & the ends where
feet would be present are eroded. The body is
convex & open and a coarse single chlor. There is
a fragmentary rectangular mouthpiece open no part or
slip. No finger design.
