well-beloved brother in Christ being
of fair character & regular standing
trustworthy and well informed in the
duties pertaining to his office
is authorized, and We do, by these
presents, authorize him, accord-
ing to the Canons & Rubrics of
our Church to preach, to admin-
ister the Holy Sacrament of Christ
and to organize parishes in this
our Diocese of Ohio in any place
or places within the precincts of
the same where his services may
be regularly required.
