Be it known, by These presents; that the
 Rev. Philander Chase Junior, being duly
 ordained a Deacon, in the Church of
 Christ according to the Canons and Rites
 of the Prot: Episcopal Church of the United
 States of America, is authorized, and I do
 by the Grace of God, authorize him to
 preach the word of God & to administer
 the Holy Sacrament of Baptism: —
 and furthermore so far as the power ec-
 clestiastical can go consistently with
 the laws civil, he is authorized to so-
 lemnize the holy Office of Matrimony
 in this state and Diocess of Ohio.
