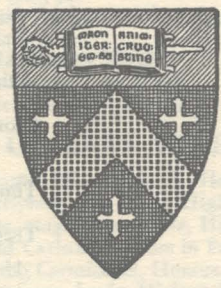
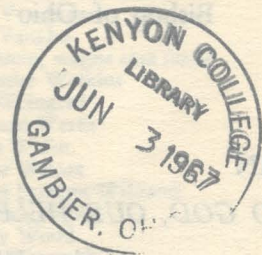

 And our eternal home. Amen.

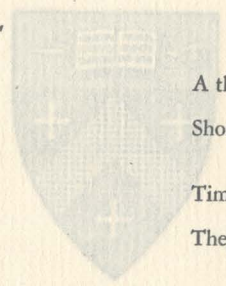
