# Building more than buildings— an interview with Philip H. Jordan, Jr.

**BULLETIN:** Can you discuss why we have had such success in recent years and what the purposes are of the building program that we have been involved in?

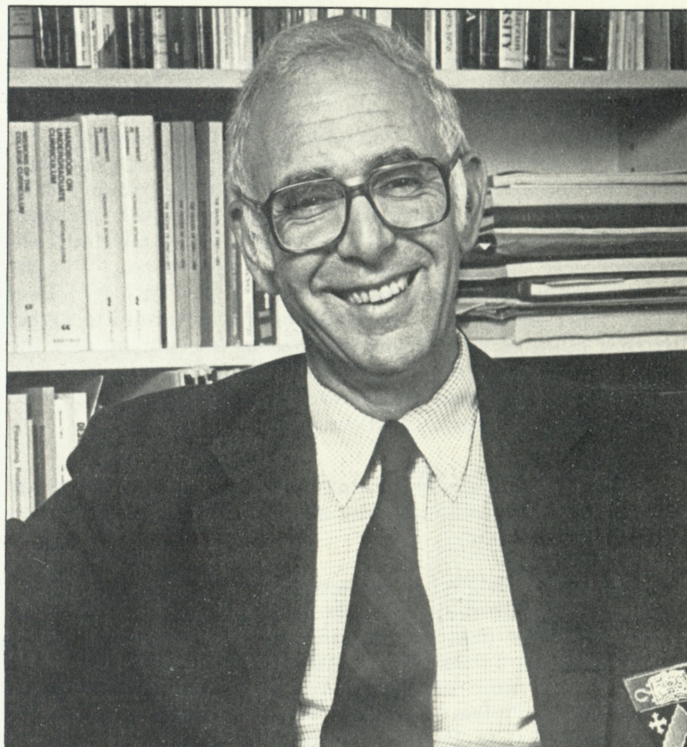
**JORDAN:** First, let me recount what Kenyon has undertaken in recent years and consider how we have succeeded in it. Then we can better address the reasons for our success.

"With the Bolton Theater four years old last fall and the ARC project—with its centerpiece, The Ernst Center—completed just before that anniversary, it may easily seem that Kenyon embarked on a building program that was completed this academic year. In fact the term "building program" gives me a start. I have thought of the Bolton and Ernst and our new dance studio and Wertheimer improved as places Kenyon needed for the academic and extracurricular activities that we are committed to. I have thought of them as drama and dance, athletics and intramurals, exercise and recreation, places for outlet and expression for students, faculty and the community. These buildings are important not simply as architectural additions to the campus, however handsome, but as value added to the work and play of Kenyon people and to the quality of life. But we did set out to enlarge Kenyon's physical plant for the enlarged College that expansion and coeducation created. And so I suppose it was a building program for that purpose, as I have myself said in an earlier "Honor Roll."

Yet we also went after other things to strengthen Kenyon at the same time. We never said, "Buildings are Kenyon's foremost need. Bricks and mortar *uber alles!*" The trustees insisted that we continue our now thirteen-year-old tradition of balanced budgets. The trustees embraced the opportunity to improve faculty salaries and to increase scholarship funds for need-based aid and for the Honors Scholar program. The trustees approved the revival of *The Kenyon Review*, the College's part in the founding of Kenyon Festival Theater, and larger investment in fund-raising, staff and publicity for the Public Affairs Conference Center. The trustees encouraged energy conservation, handicapped accessibility and upkeep of the campus, including the major renovation in Peirce Hall kitchen that is being accomplished this summer. And the trustees strongly endorsed the academic enhancements of recent years: IPHS, the Kenyon Intensive Language Model, and the new emphasis on academic computing, for example. The point is that Kenyon has been building more than buildings.

We have succeeded in doing a number of important things all at once—planning, designing, constructing and paying for two major buildings and several renovations and keeping Kenyon strong in finances, academic quality and reputation. And the result is greater confidence and ambition. Growth in ambition took place before our very eyes as we worked on the theater and the ARC. When designing the theater, we found ourselves saying: "Let's design the best educational theater of any college, one also suitable for professionals and do it all within a fixed budget limit." The ARC program, with its array of improvements, grew out of an initial scheme to slap an addition onto Wertheimer. But we came to see that Kenyon could make a quantum leap to join the best of liberal arts colleges. And we did just that. We succeeded, by this accomplishment, in raising our aspirations for the College generally as we move forward in the 'eighties.

Why did we succeed? Because the Board of Trustees properly weighted Kenyon's needs and set priorities properly. This was always done with considerable debate and awareness of alternatives: Should we build a theater, a gym or a library



addition first? Hence the case for Kenyon's needs and fund-raising was rooted in conviction, a contagious conviction, and could be explained convincingly. We succeeded because Kenyon alumni, parents and friends were extraordinarily generous in response to our needs. We succeeded because on campus and off the Kenyon constituency believed in the future of Kenyon. The evidence for that is strikingly represented by the remarkable record of giving in the 1981-82 academic year.

**BULLETIN:** Has the character or the role of the Board of Trustees changed in recent years, in your opinion, in terms of what we expect of them and what they are willing to give to the College, in terms of their personal resources and talent?

**JORDAN:** Comparisons, as they say, are invidious, and I can't compare the trustees of the past seven years with the trustees of earlier eras. Any reader of Kenyon's history, particularly in the twentieth century, can see the importance of trustees to this College. Ginn, Dempsey, Norton, Mather, Ganter, Gund, McBride, to name a few—these trustees left their mark in special funds or buildings. But I can say very definite and positive things about the present Board.

It is a very strong Board, a committed, working Board. Its members are not interested in the honorific side of their membership. They are interested in getting things done, in building a stronger, even better Kenyon. The Board has taken larger and larger responsibilities for the advancement of the College. In the 'sixties and early 'seventies the main work of the Board was to put Kenyon's fiscal affairs on a sound and stable basis. The College was expanded, the budget balanced and solvency became a requirement, a habit and a tradition. Now the Board is moving to another stage. Now the Board is saying—justly proud of recent accomplishment—"How can



we raise for Kenyon the kind of resources that colleges of our quality and reputation have raised and are raising? How can we move Kenyon significantly forward from our present achievements and strengths?"

The Board is inclined to think in large terms about Kenyon's future. The Chairman has declared that the College ought not simply to undertake "progress as usual"; we ought to go far beyond getting just a little bit better each year. And at a meeting of a Board committee last winter, a leading trustee gave directions to us administrators about plans for the future. "I want you to boggle our minds!" he challenged.

Kenyon's Board is noteworthy for its ambition for Kenyon, its generous support of the College in time, talent and significant gifts, its confidence that remarkable things can be accomplished, and, frankly, the keen personal pleasure trustees take in their work. One trustee remarked, and I am sure sincerely, though I would dispute the judgment, "I've got a whole lot more from Kenyon than I've put into it." That trustee has done so much for Kenyon that it is hard to agree. But that point of view, that enthusiasm for Kenyon and the Board's work, is not at all untypical. We continue to attract to the Kenyon Board men and women of first-rank stature who feel rewarded by their association with Kenyon.

**BULLETIN:** How does successful fundraising translate into programs on campus? How are we a better college today because of this money?

**JORDAN:** I've already spoken about some of the benefits. But let me restate them and add some more. Fiscal stability makes confident planning possible. Ambitions met awaken other ambitions. I think, for example, that the Kenyon faculty are expecting more of themselves and their colleagues as teachers and scholars or artists. We see this in teaching, in curricular ideas, in faculty development requests, in leave projects and in other ways. The higher aspirations of the whole institution are paralleled in the faculty among individuals.

The benefits of particular academic programs are well known. IPHS remains an important option in general education. The intensive language program brought new life to the teaching and learning of modern foreign languages at Kenyon and is quickening interest in intercultural study. And we are beginning to see a similar breakthrough in the study of computers and their uses in a variety of disciplines. The new attention to academic computing, language study and IPHS all were possible because of special grants from foundations. From these precedents I hope and expect other ambitions for curricular projects will follow. That is, these successes should stimulate faculty to bring forward proposals for curricular improvement in other areas.

Lest any alumnus fear that Kenyon may depart from the traditional liberal arts in pursuit of fashion, let me reassure. The faculty is vigilant to develop the curriculum to strengthen liberal education, not undermine it or water it down. And in curricular matters the faculty decides.

**BULLETIN:** What can you say about Kenyon students? What do you see in them?

**JORDAN:** I've been teaching for more than 20 years, and I have watched a number of college generations come and go. But I don't have at all the sense that the past was better than the present, even though it is somewhat fashionable to think that. Each generation has its distinctive qualities that its historical moment provides. There were aspects of the generation of the 'sixties that were really very exciting despite the excesses, and one can become almost nostalgic about the sense in which society seemed to be breaking wide-open, especially because it didn't. This generation certainly doesn't want to break open society. These young people strike me as

having a bedrock confidence that their lives can make a difference through their own personal success and through the contribution that they will make. I don't find here the preoccupation with making it in a down-side economy that is widely complained of. People on other campuses say "the students are so utilitarian, they're so concerned with the security of their own futures." I do not see that concern as the major theme of the Kenyon student body.

I see today's students first of all as pleased to be at Kenyon; believing that the choice was a good one that they are able to use well. Secondly, I think that students are much more comfortable with the older generation as a kind of companion generation, and hence I have felt a kind of ease of communication between the generations. This generation seems to come at you in a remarkably open way, trusting on the whole, rather than suspicious. They seem to me a group who are not entirely content with society as it is, but who are much more inclined to work within it, than to opt out. I don't find a lot of cynicism, I don't find a lot of discouragement in this generation, despite the state of the economy. Perhaps they are a little more open than my generation was to the unexpected in their lives. Perhaps one of the legacies of the 'sixties is the greater range of acceptable lifestyles and career lines.

Their values? Well, friendship is very important, particularly this graduating class. Relationships are important, but not in the 'sixties sense of finding a guru or a "meaningful relationship." Students continue to be gregarious. But they are becoming more interested in public issues than was true a few years ago. We saw in the 'seventies a radical falling away from the acute social awareness and involvement of the 'sixties. But we have moved through that stage of inward turning. Now I see among students a renewed desire to be conversant with major foreign policy issues, with questions of national security, and of national priority. Now, such ought to be the case and the times have something to do with it. But this is a group that wants to be more public-spirited, I think, and also wants to work within the mainstream. And they are sometimes very enterprising in their lives at Kenyon.

**BULLETIN:** Are we enhancing our stature nationally?

**JORDAN:** Yes, I think Kenyon is a good deal better known than it was, even though it has always been well known. We are somewhat better known among corporate philanthropists, and in certain centers of policy study, because of the PACC. We got a request from a major strategic planning group for galley proofs of the book that Dick Melanson is editing on Soviet-American relations in the 1980's, because it was thought to be a significant contribution. Everyone in the literary community knows about the *Kenyon Review*. The Kenyon Festival Theater is probably the single most dramatic short-term source of recognition, particularly in Ohio. It has revolutionized our recognizability in Columbus, and it's well known in other major Ohio cities. And then selectively elsewhere: New York show business knows all about it. But Kenyon is still not as well known as it ought to be, partly because it takes a long time to build a reputation that is genuinely national in character, partly because a college in Ohio is, by definition, less easily identifiable than a college in Massachusetts. New England and selective liberal arts colleges are closely wedded. But we are making progress in spreading our fine reputation, and I am optimistic that we will continue to succeed in this as in the other parts of Kenyon's accomplishment that we have discussed. What the *Kenyon Review* says is that we are a very highbrow institution; what the PACC says is that we are very serious about public issues. I think that we also need to emphasize the humane qualities of the place, balancing the seriousness and the intensity with another dimension, presenting Kenyon as "a good place to be." To some extent, it's simply telling the story that really needs to be told.

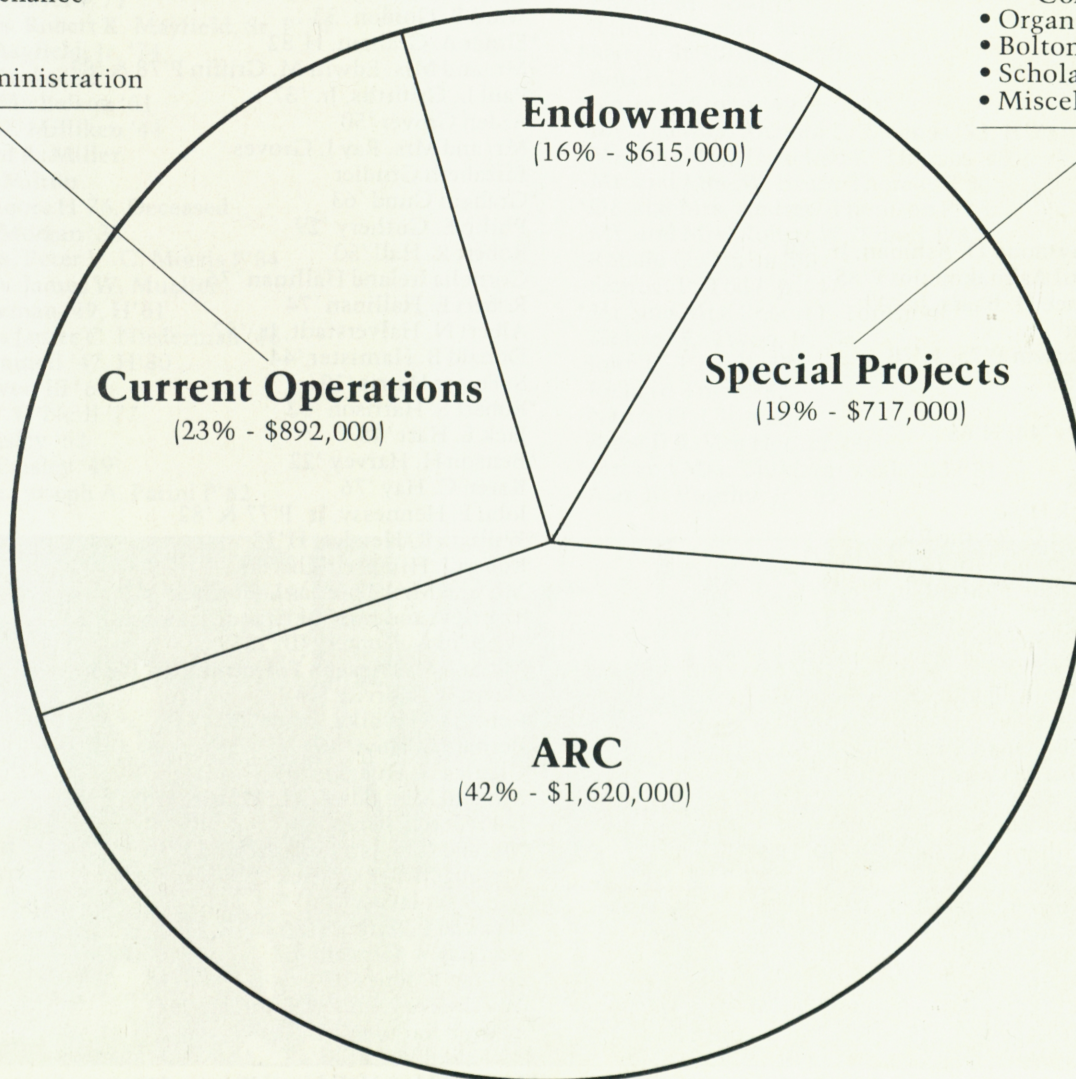

The Kenyon Fund has momentum and, with your continuing support, next year's goal will be achieved.

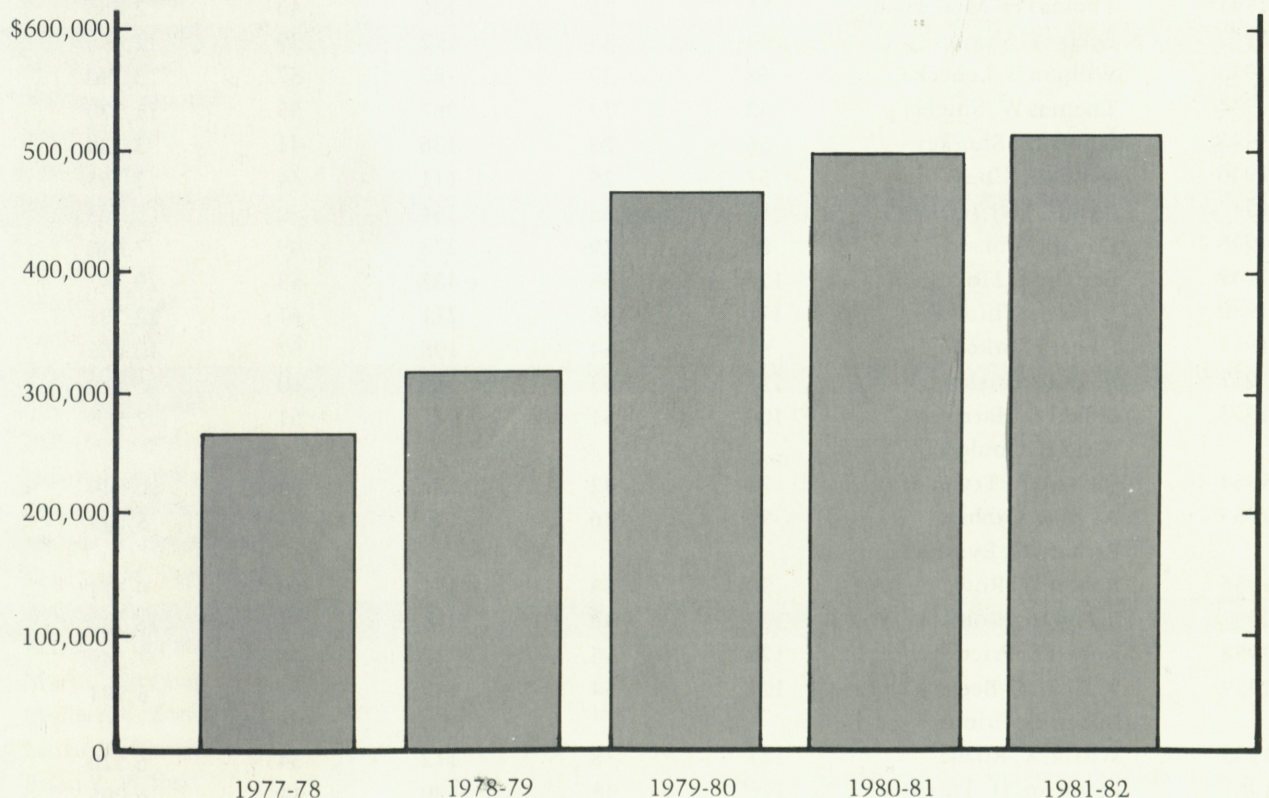

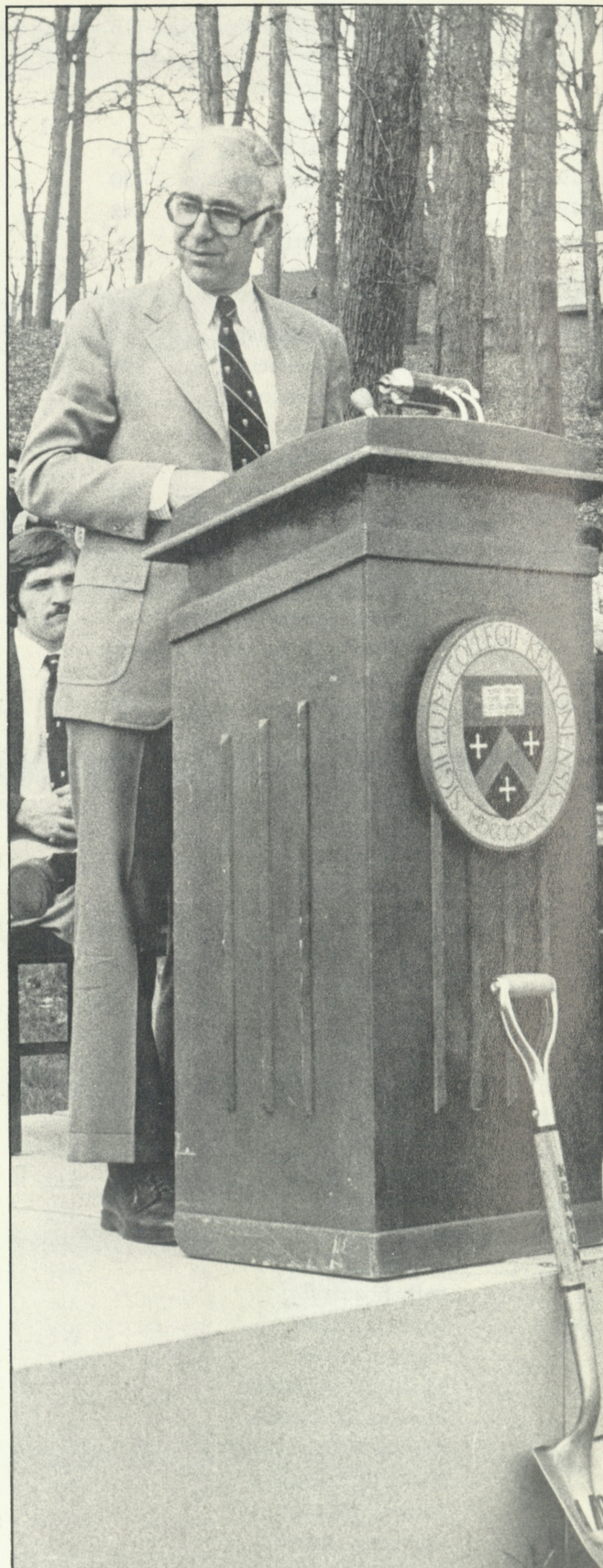

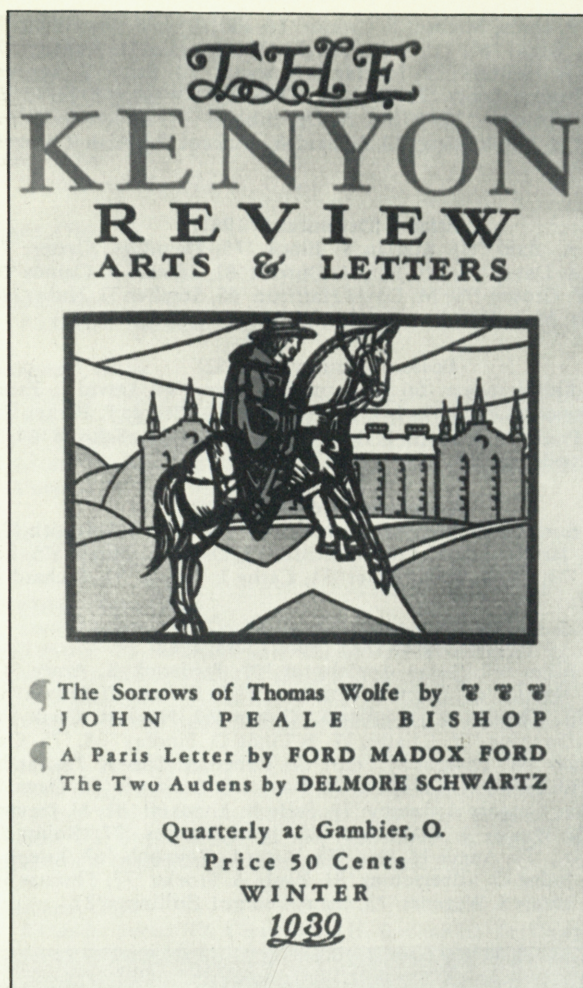

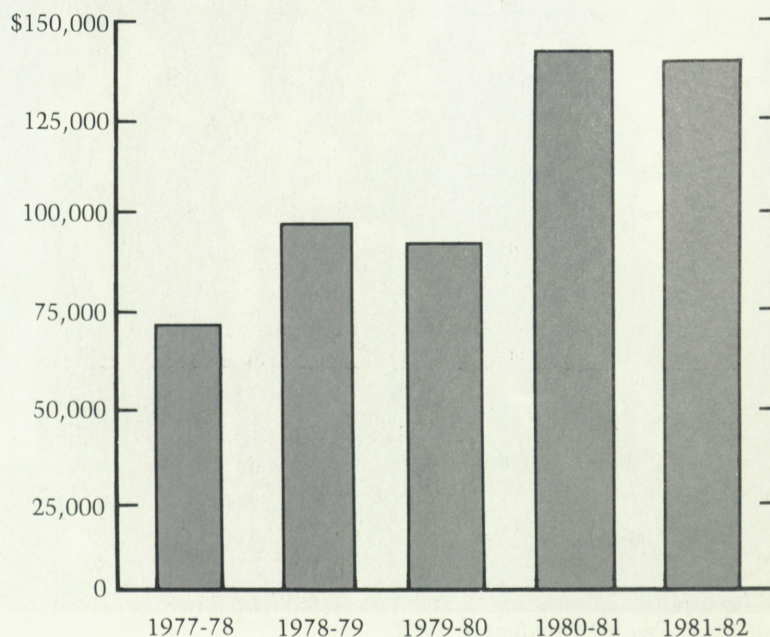

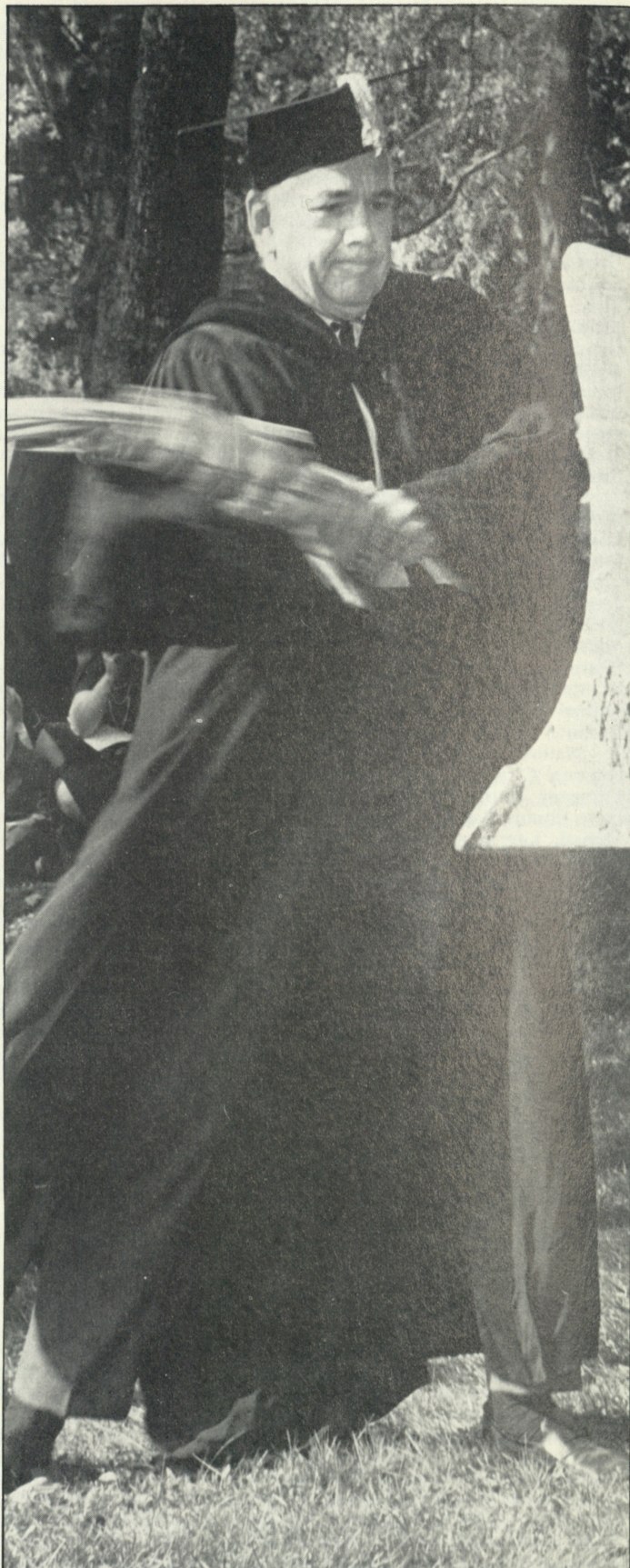
