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The theme of the project is entirely based on the story of the Tibetan Book of Birth, Day 251. This book gives a day-to-day account of the path of the human soul, from reincarnation to conception and then birth, a total of 273 days. Originally narrated by Lotus, an Indian monk, in the eighth century, the book was recalled from memory and put into writing by his fifth reincarnation in the twelfth century. Long buried in Tibet, the book was recovered by Ngä Bö at the sacred place of Mt. Kailas and subsequently brought to our attention.
