DANISH KING REPORTED PRISONER IN OWN CASTLE NEW YORK......A REPORT COMING OUT OF SWEDEN TODAY STATES THAT KING CHRISTIAN OF DENMARK (SHOMN REVIEWING TROOPS) WAS ARRESTED AND IS INTERNED IN HIS OWN CASTLE, 10 MILES NORTH OF COPENHAGEN. THIS FOLLOWED A WAVE OF STRIKES AND GENERAL SABOTAGE THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY. REPORTS ALSO STATED THAT A PART OF THE DANISH NAVY HAD BEEN SCUTTLED IN COPENHAGEN HARBOR AND OTHER DANISH WARSHIPS ESCAPED GERMAN AUTHORITIES BY FLEEING TO MALMOE IN SWEDEN.
