IN THE NEWS

Guerrilla warfare in Rhodesia was endorsed by leaders of neighboring black countries. After meeting in Dar es Salaam, the black presidents called this the only way for the territory's African nationalists to gain independence under black majority rule.

An explosion of buried atomic wastes caused the death of hundreds of Soviet citizens and radiation illness for thousands. The disaster occurred in the Ural Mountains in 1958 according to an exiled Soviet scientist now living in England.

Revival of the economy is being studied by aides of Carter and key members of Congress. The vaccination program against swine flu is lagging, causing doubt among experts as to the effectiveness of the program.
