IN THE NEWS

Two Harvard University Football players were stabbed in Boston's "adult entertainment" area on Monday. One of the students was stabbed in the heart but was brought back to life and is still in critical condition. The other youth is in good condition.

In Beirut, the Syrian peace-keeping force has been highly successful. The force has setup 52 security check points around the city and established an anti-kidnapping squad. The next move will be to secure all heavy firearms and re-open the airport.

Gilmore (the man sentenced to the death penalty) and his girlfriend are under care for an overdose of barbiturates in what seems to be a suicide attempt.

The Spanish Parliament opened discussion today on a bill to abolish itself.

Full independence for Quebec may be difficult as there is no provision for succession in the Canadian constitution. The amendment would have to be approved by the nine other provinces, the Federal Government and possibly the British Parliament.
