With the Senate approval of Griffin Bell, all but one member of Carter's cabinet have been confirmed.

It is reported that a major document will be released on Thursday by the Vatican. The document is said to contain new rulings concerning women deacons.

As temperatures drop to near zero by the end of the week, the latest cutbacks in natural gas announced by Governor Rhodes yesterday will greatly affect Central Ohio.

Andrew Young, the ambassador-designate to the UN, is expected to be confirmed in the near future. In Washington Young was called "the most powerful black in American politics".
