Sen. Robert C. Byrd urged President Carter to appoint Byrd's predecessor as Senate Majority Leader, Mike Mansfield, to head the US mission to the People's Republic of China.

The US Parole Commission ordered Watergate conspirator E. Howard Hunt released from prison Feb. 25 if he pays a \$10,000 fine still pending against him. Hunt served 2½ years of a 30 month to eight year term in a Florida prison.

Thousands of mourners jammed Madrid for the funeral of three Communist lawyers slain by rightists. Labor strikes spread across Spain as a protest against rightist violence. Premier Suarez cancelled a Middle East trip because of this violence which threatens an effort to sponsor the first elections in 41 years.

A controversial arms sale to Israel, proposed by Ford, received Carter's backing yesterday.
