### In the News

Snowplow operators and other maintenance workers failed to show up at work yesterday at Boston's Logan International Airport during a snowstorm, thus forcing the closing of the nation's eighth busiest airport.
Sources say that the proposed tax rebates will probably be denied to those with incomes of over \$25,000.
A chemical tank ruptured in Southeastern Louisiana resulting in massive clouds of chlorine gas. Several hundreds of people were evacuated.

In Dallas, Texas tank cars containing propane gas exploded, touching off several fires, which are predicted to touch off other explosions. The cause of the original explosion is not known.


