At a meeting in Geneva President Carter and Syria's President Hafez Assad outlined a peace plan agreed to by most Arab leaders. The two men discussed ways to ensure security in the Mideast, including demilitarized zones. Carter plans to send Secretary of State Cyrus Vance to the Mideast to continue the talks and finalize the plans.

UN Ambassador Andrew Young left for a 12-day tour of Africa, although South Africa hasn't said yet whether it will let him in. The ambassador will attend a meeting in Mozambique.

A late season snowstorm knocked down trees and power lines in New York and parts of New England. Snow reached depths of twelve inches in some places and fell briefly in New York City.

A stamp collection valued at \$100,000 or more was stolen from New York's public library.

Patricia Hearst was sentenced to five years' probation for shooting up in Los Angeles store.

The House Assassination Committee investigators went to Memphis for a week's study of the killing nine years ago of Martin Luther King Jr. Earl Ray is serving a 99 year sentence now.
