Fluorocarbon gas will be banned from most aerosol spray cans within two years under a federal timetable. The aim is to curb damage to the stratosphere's protective ozone layer.

The Concorde may land at New York's Kennedy airport after all. Judge Polack reversed the decision. There has been a question raised as to where funds have been coming from to finance investigations into theft and fraud in Ohio State agencies. The investigators are part of the State
