Senators Ribicoff, (D-Conn.) and Percey, (R-Ill.) have uncovered new facts about Budget Director Bert Lance's financial management of two Georgia banks. They feel they are damaging enough that Lance should resign immediately before trying to defend himself. President Carter still feels, however, that Lance will be proven innocent through further investigation.

On Monday, five terrorists kidnaped a West German industrialist and killed his chauffeur and three bodyguards. Hanns Schleyer is threatened with execution unless the West German government frees specific terrorists held prisoner in Stuttgart.

A promising economic outlook for the United States was given by economists Philip Klein and Geoffrey Moore. They stated that, of the three major industrial nations outside the Communist world, the U.S. has made the most complete recovery from the recession of 1973-1975.
