In the News

Although President Carter and Panamanian head Amar Torrijos signed the controversial Panama Canal treaties with international support from 27 world leaders present, Carter faces tough opposition both from major Senate leaders and public opinion. The treaties, which both allow Panama full control of the Canal and grant the US right of defense, must be ratified by two-thirds of the Senate.

G. Gordon Liddy, the mastermind of the 1972 Watergate burglary who has kept silent through these years, had his first day of freedom Wednesday after over 4 years in prison.

Kent State lawyers seek removal of a Supreme Court ban on construction of the gymnasium near the site of the 1970 shootings. The ban remains until the University answers the petition filed by the May 4th Coalition, which seeks a permanent ban on the gym.
