

In the News

The Federal Communications Commission last week cracked down on illegal CB radio activity. The FCC closed down 279 operations which were primarily operating on an unauthorized frequency or repeatedly interfering with TV, radio, or emergency vehicular reception. There are over 11 million CB'ers in the United States.

To a charge of loss of credibility and dishonesty, Bert Lance, the U.S. Budget Director, will present his side of the Georgia banking story at a Senate hearing this Thursday. President Carter will also discuss the matter at a news conference on Wednesday.

President Carter and Canadian Prime Minister Pierre Trudeau have agreed on a \$7.7 billion proposal for an Alcan natural gas pipeline across Canada. This route seemingly will appeal to Congress as a cheaper, more geographically equitable, and cleaner route than ones competing groups have suggested. El Paso Natural Gas Company had promoted a route adjoining the trans-Alaska oil pipeline.
