The Pulitzer Prize winning Kenyon graduate Robert Lowell, Jr. died Monday in a taxicab in New York City of an apparent heart attack. America's most distinguished modern poet, Lowell was an author of autobiographical verse and was an emphatic dissenter of the Vietnam War. Lowell graduated summa cum laude in classics in 1939.

Children's Hospital in Columbus will begin a unique 10 month state-supported experiment with epileptic children and a new drug called sodium valproate. The drug has proven itself 80% effective in arresting the disease without side effects.
