In the News

In a 6-phased transfer, the 5 Japanese terrorists who hijacked a Japanese airliner last Wednesday have received the demanded \$6 million ransom and 6 released prisoners from the Japanese government in trade for 59 of the remaining 140 hostages. The hijackers desire to fly from Bangladesh to a "friendly" revolutionary country but have not yet agreed to release any further hostages.

Afraid that the economy will not grow as hoped, President Carter's 1978 tax reform program may include a tax cut for most American families by mid-1978.

An East and Gulf coast longshoremen's strike began Saturday, October 1. Negotiations are continuing to try to resolve the dispute based on union accusations that containerization of freight causes loss of longshoreman jobs.

Pele, the brilliant Brazilian soccer star, ended his 22-year playing career this past weekend before a sellout crowd of 76,891 in Giants Stadium in New Jersey.
