In the News

Emphasizing that the energy crisis is more serious today than six months ago, President Carter is still waging an all-out war against the problem by trying to resuscitate his energy program left in shambles by the Senate. Irate toward the opportunistic attitude of the oil companies and their excess profits from a market that is not free, Carter says they "apparently want it all."

The Nobel prize for medicine was awarded today to three Americans. One half of the \$145,000 was granted to Dr. Rosalyn Yalow of the Veterans Administration hospital in the Bronx, NYC for her outstanding work on peptide production of the brain. Dr. Roger Guillemin of the Salk Institute in San Diego, California and Dr. Andrew Schally of the New Orleans Veterans Administration hospital were awarded the other half of the prize for their work on peptide hormone production. The 1977 Nobel peace prize was won by Amnesty International in London which strives for freedom for political prisoners.
