In the News

By refusing to oppose a crude oil tax proposed in President Carter's energy package, the Senate moved one step closer to formulating an energy tax bill before 1978. Russell B. Long, Chairman of the Senate Finance Committee, hopes that the bill will be a compromise of Carter's taxes to force conservation, Senate-approved tax incentives, and oil industry production incentives.

Businessmen are seeking an injunction by President Carter of the Taft-Hartley Act to halt the longshoremen's strike paralyzing movement of selective trans-oceanic shipments, soon to be mostly important Christmas merchandise. The strike, which began October 1, concerns the longshoremen's worry of job security in view of increasing automation. The trial of the three men suspected of kidnapping 26 Chowchilla, California schoolchildren and their bus driver in July of 1976 will begin this week. The children will be asked to testify about the hijacking of their bus and their 16 hour entombment.
