Although military and economic sanctions were vetoed, the Western powers of the U.N. Security Council proposed an indefinite arms embargo against Ian Smith's South African government. The 49 African nations are conferring to formulate a response.

Retail prices of groceries in Ohio rose 2¢ during October as shown by a survey of 16 items compared each month in Ohio's supermarkets. The cost of the 16 items currently is \$23.74; at this time in 1975 the cost for the same items was \$18.60.
