An attack by Israeli war planes in retaliation for a Palestinian rocket attack on Israel has left over 100 dead in Lebanon. Though Israel claims the attacks centered on military targets, the rubble and victims once made up small civilian villages, now devastated. President Carter is pleased with the present leveling off of the unemployment rate to 7%. He says his economic stimulus package, designed to further eradicate joblessness, will aid even more in 1978 when the funds are pumped into the economy.
