Eager to have the Panama Canal Treaties approved, Panamanian leader Omar Torrijos declared he would resign his office if he is an obstacle to ratification. Torrijos also offered to abolish various human rights violations. Six U.S. senators have just concluded a tour of Panama and the Canal Zone and are reporting back to the Senate on their findings.

The Environmental Protection Agency is fully investigating the possibility that diesel fuel fumes may be a carcinogen. Mutated bacteria formed from exposure to the fumes may have cancer-causing qualities. At present, no warnings have been given to travelers.

52 persons were killed and thousands left homeless when 30 tons of dynamite exploded in a parked freight train in Ira, Korea. The city was reduced to rubble; damage is estimated at \$10 million. Officials suspect arson as the cause of the blast.
