

In the News

Attempting to bypass years of haggling over peace terms, Egypt's President Anwar Sadat has proposed a meeting in Cairo beginning December 2 as a prelude to a Geneva Middle East peace conference. Sadat has invited Israel, which plans to accept; Syria has repudiated the invitation. Other Arab nations, the Soviet Union, and the United States have been invited but have made no commitment as yet.

Although the East Coast longshoremen's strike may end Tuesday with a vote by all the members of the Longshoremen's Association, business has been seriously impaired by the delay of exports and imports. Much merchandise for Christmas, tied up by the strike, has been cancelled by merchants, and some goods will arrive too late for holiday sale. An estimated loss to the GNP of \$1.3 billion has been caused by the strike to guarantee longshoremen income protection in the face of increasing automation.
