### In the News

President Anwar Sadat of Egypt has proposed a meeting in Cairo in preparation for a Geneva Middle East peace conference. The United States, Israel, and Egypt will attend the meeting which could begin this Saturday while Syria, the PLO, and Jordan have refused to attend. Dependent on Syria's stand, the Russians and Lebanese will abstain from the conference.

Rhodesian troops have claimed to have killed 1,200 black guerrillas in Mozambique. The black nationalists trying to prepare for black rule in Ian Smith's white-ruled Rhodesia doubt the claim in full, but the black effort has undoubtedly been greatly hindered.
