Arab allies have joined forces in Libya to reject Egypt's attempts for a negotiated peace agreement with Israel. Presidents of Algeria, Syria, Libya, and high representatives of Iraq are attempting to embody "the will of the Arab nation to fight all imperialist and Zionist conspiracies and to frustrate the surrender and deceit settlement."

The crude oil tax, the heart of President Carter's energy proposal to force conservation, seems doomed in the Senate as influential senators fear that the oil companies are going to reap excessive profits from the tax. President Carter vows, however, that the tax will be rebated to the consumers.
