In the News

As a reaction to the hanging execution of two black murderers, riots have broken out in Bermuda and have resulted in over \$4 million in damages. Officials have appealed to Britain for troop aid to quell the riots.

Serious reprimands and expressions of shock and anger from the U.S., the U.N., and some South Africans have been directed at the verdict handed down by Magistrate Prins on Steven Biko's death. Prins found no one criminally responsible for the infliction of serious brain damage and later death of Biko, a black consciousness leader who was being detained in prison. Biko died September 12, 1977 within the prison.

Libya, Syria, and Iraq are forming a hard line stand against Egypt and its negotiations with Israel. Khadafy of Libya is urging imposing an economic embargo against Egypt. Assad of Syria, however, is wary of too harsh a stand which could break ties between allies Syria and Egypt.
