# In the News

The United Mine Workers began a strike Monday which has cut off all pay checks and health insurance benefits to all miners. The union carries no reserve funds to help tide over the 10,000 Ohio and all other U.S. coal miners through the Christmas season. A quick settlement is not expected.

At the end of one of history's most divisive, lengthy, and complicated battles between the House and Senate, Congress has agreed to liberalize the present law allowing federal funding for abortions for low-income women. Many congressmen advocated a ban on the use of federal funds (Medicaid) for any such abortions regardless of circumstance.
