In the News

After completing a 9 day worldwide tour including stops in India, Europe, and the Middle East, President Carter expressed satisfaction that his trip displayed America and her democracy in a very good light and will aid future negotiations in the Middle East peace talks. He added that his trip represented "the power and influence and goodwill of the United States." The President made a successful, previously unannounced stop in Egypt to confer with President Sadat over misconceptions about the Palestinian selfdetermination question.

After 45 years of performances in Rockefeller Center, Radio City Music Hall will close this spring. The famous Rockettes, an American institution, will form a final chorus line on April 12, 1978.

After Vietnamese troops have advanced 20 miles into Cambodian territory, the fighting seems to be temporarily at a standstill after 4 months of border conflict.
