### In the News

Cambodia has claimed the latest victories in the traditional border conflict with Vietnam, saying troops have regained the territory called the Parrot's Beak off the Vietnamese border. Vietnam has denied the statement, and Americans studying the war doubt it, too, feeling Vietnam has far superior fighting forces.

President Carter is nearing the end of his search for a new FBI director to replace Clarence Kelley who will retire upon appointment of a successor. U.S. District Judge Frank J. McGarr of Chicago and federal appellate Judge William H. Webster of St. Louis seem likely candidates. Carter's first choice, U.S. District Judge Frank M. Johnson of Alabama, declined the appointment after difficulties arising after surgery.

Manufacturers of the tranquilizer Valium dispute the FDA's warning to doctors that a patient's use of the drug be reassessed after four months usage. The makers say the drug is obviously effective and, thus, used widely. The FDA states that the drug's effectiveness

has not been measured and is not assured after four months usage.
