With the coal strike already 2 months old, federal mediators are trying to put together an economic package, along with tentative retirement and health benefits, that will serve to end the strike. Meanwhile, with coal for electric power in short supply in Ohio, the Ohio Power Company urges all its consumers to conserve whatever energy they can so as to make supplies last as long as possible. President Carter has no plan, as yet, to invoke the Taft-Hartley Act, which would force miners back to work for an 80-day "cooling off" period. He feels there is no emergency situation at the present time.

The search for a Soviet nuclear-powered spy satellite, which fell out of orbit January 24, 1978 has come to an end in the Canadian Northwest Territories. A 2-man dog team and 4 companions found, by coincidence, scattered debris burned into the frozen Thelon River. Medical examination of the men indicated no radiation contamination.
