

In the News

Egyptian President Anwar Sadat met this past weekend with President Carter who emphasized that both Israel and Egypt will have to compromise to form a true Middle East peace settlement. Carter stated firmly that the U.S. will be a negotiations "mediator" only. He will not pressure Israel to come forward first with concessions to resume the talks which Egypt feels have been hampered by unreasonable Israeli stubbornness.

After discovering bits of debris from a Soviet nuclear spy satellite which fell to earth in late January, 1978, the Canadian government, along with the U.S., is still continuing a search for possible radioactive contamination. So far, over \$1 million has been spent on the search, which includes 400 personnel and over 12 aircraft. Canada is considering billing the U.S.S.R. for all expenses. The Soviets have offered technical assistance but have not yet been told of the discoveries of the satellite's fragments.
