In the News

Security was extremely tight in Rome Saturday as representatives from over 100 nations and all of Italy's leaders came to pay final respects to kidnapped and slain Aldo Moro, once leader of the Christian Democrats. Pope Paul VI, in a rare sojourn from the Vatican, led the service in the great Basilica of St. John Lateran while thousands filled the piazza outside.

President Carter's hotly disputed package to sell war aircraft to Saudi Arabia, Egypt, and Israel is presently before the Senate and is predicted to pass narrowly. The Saudis are unhappy, however, about possible restrictions placed upon them regarding where the warplanes can be based.
