## In the News

Iran is experiencing a very confused upheaval. While pro-shah supporters of Prime Minister Bakhtiar demonstrated in the streets countered by anti-shah supporters, the military kept Iranian airports sealed from traffic. Bakhtiar declared that he will allow his countrymen to opt for a monarchy or a republic led by Khomeini — if Khomeini will delay his planned return. However, Khomeini feels the offer is a ruse to bar entirely the ayatollah from Iran. Some feel Khomeini may order his followers to war if the "treasonous" government does not allow him to enter Iran by Sunday when the airports are scheduled to reopen.
