

In the News

The Commerce Department announced yesterday that the economy slowed its growth in the first quarter of 1979 and that inflation continued to increase. The report by the department said that the GNP increased only .7%, as opposed to a 6.9% increase in the final three quarters of 1978. The report also said inflation was at 8.7% in this first quarter, compared to 8.2% for the end of 1978.
