

In the News

Two Irishmen, possible IRA guerrillas, have been charged with the bomb slaying of Lord Louis Mountbatten who was killed when his yacht exploded in the Irish Sea on a fishing expedition. The IRA earlier claimed responsibility for the killing. Pope John Paul II has cancelled his visit to Ireland - part of his itinerary including a trip to the United States - in the wake of the escalated violence there. British officials now fear the IRA guerrillas, a strong, well-equipped, sophisticated network of organization, may include SAM anti-aircraft missiles as part of their strike force in their intense effort to eradicate British rule in Northern Ireland.
