In the News

The Vietnamese-controlled government of Phnom Penh, Cambodia, finally will allow massive aid for thousands on the verge of dying from disease and starvation resulting from continuous war and social turmoil. Relief from 30 nations will arrive by airlift to deliver medicine and over \$100 million in food supplies. Final plans are being made for over \$7 million to be delivered this year from the US, and Congress will vote on a pending bill to send \$20-30 million in 1980 to Cambodia.

In a meeting with two congressmen Saturday, Cuban President Castro says that, while he thinks the US is needlessly blowing out of proportion the Cuban-based Russian troop situation, he desires better relations with the US and feels Havana and Washington should establish diplomatic ties. Relations between the two countries have been broken since 1961 after Casto's revolution resulted in expulsion of Americans and closer Moscow ties.
